

General Council's Resolution on the Support for Ukrainian Higher Education Students in Emergency Situation for Humanitarian Reasons

Considering the situation of crisis lived in Ukraine, which is preventing the regular functioning of its institutions of Higher Education.

Considering the *Rapid Response Mechanism for Higher Education in Emergencies* initiative, former Emergency Academic Support - Global Platform for Syrian Students set up by President Jorge Sampaio.

Considering that it is the role of the General Council of Universidade de Lisboa, as the proposal of the Rector, the fixing of the value of the tuition fees for degree conferring courses.

Considering that, for humanitarian reasons, the minimum possible value for tuition must be fixed for students integrated in the *Rapid Response Mechanism for Higher Education in Emergencies*.

The General Council of Universidade de Lisboa, as proposed by the Rector, deliberates:

- 1- Dismiss Ukrainian students who benefit from *Rapid Response Mechanism for Higher Education in Emergencies* who attend, or will attend, master's or doctoral study cycles at the Universidade de Lisboa, from the payment of tuition fees in relation to the attendance of these study cycles during their normal duration.
- 2- In situations where students benefit from a scholarship, the value of the tuition is fixed at the amount corresponding to the payment component of the tuition.
